Pickup Information

We would like to remind you of our pickup policy:

- Only those named on your child’s paperwork are allowed to collect your children from nursery and they will need the password. If they are not familiar to nursery staff, they will be asked to confirm their personal details we hold for them.
- If you need to send someone who is not registered on your paperwork, you must call the office to confirm their name and relationship to child. They will also need your child’s password.
- Anyone collecting your child must be at least 16 years of age.
