We wish our children who are moving up to primary school, the very best in their next step. For our children returning to us, we look forward to welcoming you back in September.

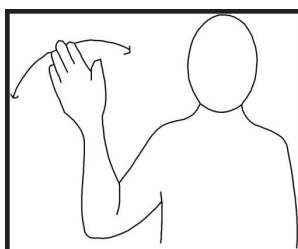
