What we have been learning...

This week Concept Cat came to teach us all about "straight". The children explored drawing a range of marks across the areas of nursery. The children explored marks that were "straight" and "not straight".

This week we rounded up our core text "Owl Babies". We explored making nests for birds to keep them safe and warm over winter and used our knowledge of straight and curved

lines to create representations of owls.


In our story sessions we have been using our knowledge of the story to repeat Bill's words. Now we are starting to understand how to use the author's words to retell the story.



Each week we are going to introduce a new Makaton sign. Makaton is a unique communication programme that uses symbols (pictures), signs (gestures) and speech to enable people to communicate. It supports the development of essential communication skills such as attention and listening, comprehension, memory, recall and organisation of language and expression.
