



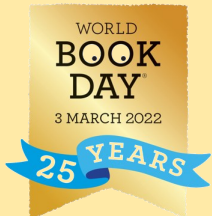

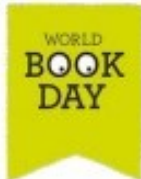
Collecting Children Early
