What we have been learning this week...

This week we have been exploring different cultures around the world. We compared the environment around us to that of Australia. We brought the learning to life through the story of "No Room for a Baby Roo". This explored the Australian outback and the animals in it. We compared and contrasted our surroundings to the illustrations in the story. We hunted around our environment for natural items. We then used the items that we found to create pictures.

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We also compared the different birds and animals we see in our environment to those in Australia. We used our bird hide to observe the birds in our environment. We saw crows, blackbirds, magpies and seagulls and used information to find out more about these birds.





Each week we are going to introduce a new Makaton sign. Makaton is a unique communication programme that uses symbols (pictures), signs (gestures) and speech to enable people to communicate. It supports the development of essential communication skills such as attention and listening, comprehension, memory, recall and organisation of language and expression.
