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Home learning for week beginning 25th January 2021

This week we are continuing to learn about The Gingerbread Man and looking at rain and mud due to the weather.

Activities for you to carry out

1. It has been raining lots this week we will be focusing on rain and mud. There are lots of songs we can sing about rain. Singing helps us to develop vocabulary and learn repetitive phrases.
2. Can you sing the song rain rain go away which can be found at:

3. Can you go on an adventure in the rain. Where can you walk to? How many puddles can you jump in? Can you add food colouring to your puddles?
4. There has been so much rain this week can you make a rain gage and see how much rain falls? Can you count how many centimeters of rain have fallen? Please see below for an idea.



5. We are going to read two stories this week 'Rain' which is non-fiction book and 'Owl Babies' which is a fiction book please find them on the Facebook and YouTube page this week they will be read by one of our wonderful key workers. Can you answer the questions in the video?

Group Times

1. PSED. We are reading the story "Owl Babies" we have some new children that have started nursery. The story focuses on a mummy owl that leaves her babies. The babies wonder where she has gone. We will be discussing feelings and how the owl babies may feel using key vocabulary such as happy, sad, scared.
2. Maths. In nursery we are looking at simple 2D shapes. We are going to play a shape memory game and try and match two shapes that are the same. Can you find any simple shapes at home such as circle, square, triangle, rectangle?
3. Phonics. This week we are going to Sing the song 'Mrs Browning has a bag'. In the bag there will be objects that make sounds an adult will put their hand into the bag and make one of the objects make a sound. A child will then identify the object. The child will then be shown the object. This will then be repeated for another object in the bag. Can you find any objects that make noises at home?
4. Early talk boost. This session aims to help to support children with their speaking and vocabulary. Children will be holding the drain pipe, and given a ball. They will then aim to aim the drainpipe to their friend and roll the ball down it when they have said Ready, steady "GO". Can you roll balls at home saying "Ready, steady, go"?
