It can also offer the 2 year old government free funded 15 hour places if you meet the eligibility criteria. 

Induction Process





New Parents Meeting: Wednesday 15th June 2022 Home Visits: : 1st, 2nd and 3rd September 2022

Start Date for Nursery: Each child will be allocated a start date. You will then stay with your child for the week or as long as is needed. It is important that both yourself and your child feel safe and have built a relationship with their keyworker before they are left alone.

Evidence really does demonstrate that it is important for the child to feel safe in a new relationship before they can detach from their secure parent/carer. Please trust us with this and enable the time for you to be able to support your induction slowly and at the pace of your individual child.

School Information



Basnett Street Nursery School and The Chatterbox Club Fund

For all children receiving the free early years entitlement funding (15 hours free sessions) there is a voluntary contribution of £2.50 per week or 50p per session for those children in Chatterbox not accessing the full 5 days. This is collected in nursery school and The Chatterbox Club every week. We rely very heavily on this money to fund a wide range of exciting activities such as baking, malleable play, toys/resources, parties and other special events on offer to your children. These charges are separate to the Chatterbox Club's session charges.

Healthy School

We have fruit sharing days every day and on a Monday we ask every child to being a piece of fruit which enables the children to continue enjoying fruit sharing.



Each week your child will bring a book bag, reading journal and book home for you to read together and you can then use the reading journal to let us know whether you enjoyed the story or not. Do not feel you have to write a comment, a smiley face or a sad face will do in the comment box if you so wish. You can keep the book for a week and then return it in your child's book bag.

Accidents and Medication

All staff are Paediatric First Aid qualified with Gillian Burnie and Grace Walker also First Aid trained. Parents are requested to provide emergency contact numbers in case the nursery school and the chatterbox club need to contact you. If your child becomes unwell during the session or if your child suffers from an accident which requires home or hospital treatment we will use the numbers provided to make contact with you. We are able to give your child prescribed medicines only if your child suffers from a specific medical condition. This should be provided in the original packaging, named and dated and with full written instructions and a medical form completed by parents.

Parking

In order to ensure the safety of our children and families, we would like to remind you NOT TO PARK or wait ON THE YELLOW ZIG ZAG LINES outside the building. This is to ensure all our children and parents have a safe journey to and from school.



School Information

Absence & Illness

Daily attendance is expected but if your child is absent from nursery, please inform the office before their start time or within 30 minutes of the session starting. We always contact parents to enquire about their child's whereabouts if we do not hear from yourselves.

Attendance is monitored closely and if attendance is low we will send attendance letters to your home to find out if a place is still required.

Holiday absence forms are available from the school office. Holidays can be taken for up to 2 weeks maximum in school time. Places may have to be forfeited if we have a waiting list.



Safeguarding Our Children

Children must be brought and collected by an adult over the age of 16 years old. If for any reason the regular person can not collect your child you must inform nursery of any changes.

Mobile Phone use is prohibited in the nursery. Anyone dropping off or picking up a child will not be able to use their mobile phone whilst they are in the building.

Online Safety

We can reassure you that all our ICT equipment is filtered and monitored to an extremely high level to ensure your children are safeguarded.

We do not allow parents to bring in cameras or any other video devices to any of the school special events.



What to Wear



Uniform (Optional)

Labelling

Please make sure that all items of clothing are clearly labelled with your child's name. This helps us to locate any missing clothing quickly.





Outdoor Play



Your child will have access to the outdoor play area every day. We provide rain coats, waterproof trousers and wellies. It is important that you provide your child with outdoor clothing that is suitable for the weather depending on the time of year. It would be helpful if you could provide your child with a spare bag of clothes.

Complaints Procedure

We aim to have staff available to ensure that parents/carers can discuss any issues of concern so as to avoid unnecessary distress.

Parents/Carers may in the first instance take any complaint to the Headteacher Mrs Lindsay Ingham or the Manager of The Chatterbox Club, Mrs Grace Walker We will always give serious consideration to concerns and complaints that are brought to the schools attention. We will ensure that the concern/complaint is dealt with effectively and with fairness to all parties. Where possible we will always try to resolve complaints informally.

If we feel that the complaint regarding the nursery school can not be resolved informally we will follow Lancashire County Council's formal complaints procedures (if you would like a copy of this please see the Headteacher). If we feel that the complaint regarding The Chatterbox Club cannot be resolved informally, the concern/complaint will need to be put in writing to the Chairperson of the Management Committee, using the Chatterbox Club address.
