Basnett Street Nursery School is a maintained nursery run by the local authority. We are a flexible provision and can provide up to 30 hour places for 3 and 4 year olds. The Chatterbox Club is an extended provision of the nursery and can provide up to 30 hour places for 2 year olds. We work in partnership to provide your child with a welcoming and safe environment to enjoy a stimulating and multi-sensory pre-school learning experience.

Session Times and Prices

Both provisions can provide full day childcare from 8.45am until 3.40pm subject to availability and your funding eligibility.

If your child is attending on a 15 hour funded place, you will be assigned either a morning or afternoon place and your child will attend 5 days per week. **Morning sessions run from 8.45am until 11.45am. Afternoon sessions run from 12.40pm until 3.40pm.**

If your child is attending on a **30 hour place**, your child will attend from **9.40am until 3.40pm**. Early access is available from 8.45am and you will be billed for the extra hour as per session prices below.

30 hour children staying for lunch will need to bring a healthy packed lunch as we do not have the facilities to provide lunch onsite. Please ensure your child does not bring any sweets or chocolates in their packed lunch. A drink is not required as milk and water will be provided.

Snack is freely available throughout both morning and afternoon sessions for your child to enjoy. We ask parents to contribute to snack by bringing in fruit and vegetables each week - the donation basket is in reception. Your child will have access to milk and water to drink.

If you require additional hours outside your funding agreement, please speak to us to arrange your flexible contract and you will be invoiced accordingly. Session prices are detailed below:

We want you to feel welcomed into Basnett Street Nursery School and work with you to support your child. We very much appreciate your interest and involvement. This can be in many different ways such as reading with your child at home, getting involved in your child's learning and interests, bringing items from home and joining in with special events etc. You will be regularly kept up to date in regards to your child's progress through planned parents meetings and daily discussions with your child's keyworker.

Nursery Induction Process







A home visit will be arranged with you before your child starts nursery. You will receive a letter stating your home visit date and official start date.

During your child's first week, you will stay at nursery with your child for shorter sessions to help them settle in. Your keyworker will communicate with you on when sessions can be increased and when your child can attend nursery without you.

Please be aware that you may need to stay with your child for longer than one week. It is important both yourself and your child feel safe and have built a relationship with their keyworker before they are left alone. We understand this can be difficult when navigating personal commitments, but please trust us with this very important stage of your child's nursery journey.

Do not be alarmed if your child takes longer than another child to settle at nursery. All children react differently and we will work with you accordingly.

Prepping for Nursery

Here are some ideas to help you prepare your child for starting nursery:

- Talk to your child about the fun they will have at nursery.
- Do nursery activities at home such as nursery rhymes, painting, crafting and water play.
- Never threaten your child with 'telling the teacher'.
- Always remind your child that you will leave them at nursery but that you will be back to collect them.
- Dress your child in clothes with easy fastenings to help promote independent toileting.
- Show an interest in what they have done at nursery but do expect them to be reluctant.
 They may be overwhelmed and will share experiences with you when ready to do so.
- Nursery can be very exhausting. Allow children extra cuddles and time to rest.



Important Information

Snack

There is a fruit basket in reception. **We ask our families to donate fruit and vegetables** every week for children to share at snack times. You do not need to send your child in with a snack.

Nuts

We are a nut free school. Please do not send nuts or food containing nuts into school.

Healthy School

As we are a healthy school, **sweets and chocolate are not allowed** onsite or in children's packed lunch/bags.

Lunch

Children staying for lunch will need to **bring a healthy packed lunch each day**. Our full lunch policy can be found on our website - www.basnettstreet.lancs.sch.uk.

School Fund

We ask for a donation of £3 per week to help fund our exciting activities such as baking, parties, special events and keeping our resources topped up. This can be paid in cash at reception or via bank transfer. This is separate to session charges.

Library

Your child will bring home a new library book each week. Please indicate in the reading journal whether your child enjoyed the book. **This will need returning to nursery every week.** Missing or damaged books may result in a £5 charge.

Parking

Basnett Street is a very busy street but we ask you to be courteous to local residents when parking.

Please do not use the staff car park, move the yellow cones or park on the yellow zig zag lines outside of school. Emergency vehicles need to be able to access the nursery at all times.

Accidents and Medication

All staff are Paediatric First Aid qualified with some holding an additional First Aid qualification. You will need to consent to your child receiving emergency medical treatment on your registration paperwork. Please keep the school office informed to any changes in contact information should we need to contact you in an emergency.

If your child has a medical condition that requires medication, we are able to administer this. The medicine must be given to us in original packaging, unopened, named and dated and full instructions must be given in an accompanying medical form.



Important Information

Absence and Illness

Good attendance is important for your child's learning and development and daily attendance is expected. Continuous, poor attendance can put your child's place at nursery at risk. You must ring the nursery daily to inform of your child's absence - 01282 457235.

Medical appointments should be made outside of session times where possible.

Holidays

As we are a local authority nursery, **we open term time only**. An up to date holiday list is available on our website - www.basnettstreet.lancs.sch.uk.

We encourage holidays to be taken in school holidays and we will only allow a maximum of 10 days extra holiday to be taken without your child's place being at risk.

Safeguarding

Children must be collected by an authorised person who you have named on your registration paperwork and they must be at least 16 years of age. They will need to know your child's password that you have set on the registration form.

If a non-authorised person needs to collect in an emergency, you must inform nursery to prevent delays at pickup time.

Mobile phones and devices are not allowed to be used in nursery and must be put away at the front door.

Home Language

We recognise that bilingualism is a true asset and will encourage children to use both home language and English in nursery. Where possible, children will be grouped by home language so they have opportunities to develop their communication skills further.

Online Safety

Our ICT equipment is filtered and monitored to keep your child safe in nursery. Parents, carers and children are not allowed to bring phones and personal devices into school.

Please support our online safety focus by monitoring what your child watches at home and being mindful of screen time.



Nursery Kit List

Your child will need to bring a bag into nursery each day containing nappies, spare socks and underwear plus a change of clothing. Please ensure all items have your child's name stamped into them.

We will provide rain coats, waterproof trousers and wellies for outdoor play but you will also need to supply additional items depending on the time of year:

Spring/Summer - please ensure your child has suncream applied before coming to nursery and pack a sunhat. We provide top up suncream if consent has been provided on the registration paperwork.

Autumn/Winter - please ensure your child has appropriate footwear, a warm coat plus hat, scarf and gloves.





Uniform

Uniform at Basnett Street Nursery School is recommended but not compulsory. Wearing uniform encourages a sense of belonging and protects personal clothes but is your choice as to whether you purchase this.

Our uniform is a jade jumper (£10.80) or cardigan (£12.55) and a yellow polo shirt (£8.55). We would recommend wearing this with dark leggings or jogging pants. Comfortable shoes must be worn.

Children can get very messy at nursery so please do not send them in their best clothes.



Complaints Procedure

Our staff are always available for parents/carers to discuss any concerns.

If you feel your child's keyworker cannot help, you can speak with Mrs Lindsay Ingham (Headteacher) or Mrs Grace Walker (The Chatterbox Club Manager). We will always give serious consideration to concerns and complaints that are brought to the nursery's attention. We will ensure that the concern/complaint is dealt with effectively and with fairness to all parties. Where possible we will always try to resolve complaints informally.

If we feel that the complaint regarding Basnett Street Nursery School can not be resolved informally we will follow Lancashire County Council's formal complaints procedures (if you would like a copy of this please see the Headteacher). If we feel that the complaint regarding The Chatterbox Club cannot be resolved informally, the concern/complaint will need to be put in writing to the Chairperson of the Management Committee, using The Chatterbox Club address.
